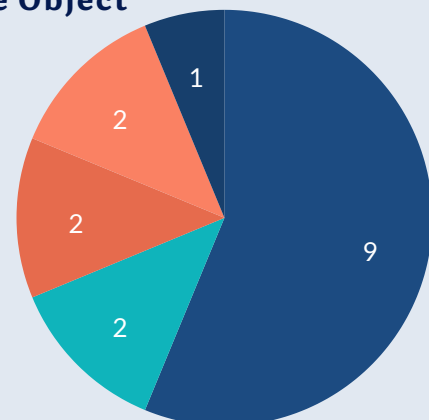

Litigation

In 15 criminal proceedings investigated by the Bureau, **13 officials were convicted**: 10 from the SP, 2 from the SBG, and 1 from the PA, and **2 officials were acquitted**: 1 from the SP and 1 from the MP.

Key Preventive Measures in the First Quarter of 2026

Training for officials of the Prison Administration: "Official powers and use of force: boundaries and responsibility";

Discussion with representatives of non-governmental organizations on the Bureau's competence, cooperation in the field of prevention, and challenges in preventing crimes committed by officials;

Meeting with officials of the Internal Control Bureau of the State Police on preventive functions and cooperation in the investigations of criminal offences;

Workshop with officials of the Prison Administration: "Exchange of best practices and experience in investigative matters" and "Legal and practical aspects of internal investigations".
